Welcome to the *Ellendale way of life*

Cedar Woods is committed to creating a flourishing natural environment at Ellendale, establishing a true oasis just 12km from Brisbane CBD.

Green priority

Every aspect of Ellendale's design and landscape reflects our commitment to the environment.

During the design process, important natural features were identified and enhanced to provide both ecological and aesthetic value. This included carefully mapping out every tree so our team could design around the existing environment.

Over 40 per cent of Ellendale is reserved for open space and retained natural bushland, creating a tranquil community amongst the trees. 91 hectares will be dedicated to natural bushland and landscaped parklands. This will

further enhance the connection to nature and help fauna and bushland continue to thrive.

Careful water management means all water used in Ellendale landscaping is returned to Cedar Creek as clean water. This is achieved through water management planning and water sensitive urban design.

Rehabilitation of our nature corridors has seen more than 180,000 new trees planted throughout the community, as well as nesting boxes, glider poles and fauna underpasses to allow wildlife to move freely around Ellendale's nature corridors.



Parks and recreation

Ellendale offers a range of community facilities, designed to create a closer connection to the natural environment.

The local Ellendale Park features a state-ofthe-art playground with an eight-metre play tower, climbing nets, swings, see-saw and shade sails. It's the perfect place to relax amongst the trees and spot wildlife.

A series of walkways and bike paths meander through Ellendale's tree-lined streets, perfect for relaxing afternoon strolls or dog walks. You'll find shelters and bench seating located throughout the walkways, giving you the opportunity to sit back and take in the stunning surroundings.

Community connection

Close to the city, but without the hustle and bustle, Ellendale offers access to a richly diverse range of local amenities.

You'll find everything you need close to home, including a range of local primary and high schools, bustling retail precincts, cafés, restaurants, and a myriad of local sporting venues and clubs.
