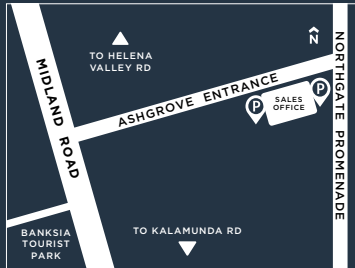
Join Studio 88 and your Bushmead neighbours every Saturday morning from 9am at Giants Park for a 45 minute guided session with Bushmead resident Kym.
